RESPONSE OF SESU UNITS TO DANGEROUS EVENTS

Since the beginning of the large-scale war of Russia against Ukraine the SESU units made:

- 134,182 responses were made to eliminate the consequences of shelling;
- 17,588 fires were extinguished;
- 4,834 people have been rescued;
- the bodies of 2,867 people were found;
- psychological assistance was provided to 235,458 people.

DEMINING OF THE LIBERATED FROM THE OCCUPIERS

SETTLEMENTS AND TERRITORIES

Since the beginning of the war, 82375 engagements have been carried out, 467840 UXOs have been found, removed and disposed of, including 3153 aircraft bombs, and an area of 114875 hectares has been surveyed.

CONSEQUENCES OF SHELLING BY RUSSIAN TROOPS

ON THE SESU UNITS

As a result of hostilities, 84 rescuers-firefighters were killed, 313 rescuers-firefighters were injured, 5 rescuers-firefighters were held hostage and 1 person went missing.

Destroyed and damaged: 1,655 fire-fighting and rescue engines (1,004 captured, 97 destroyed, 554 damaged);

391 fire stations (25 destroyed, 366 damaged).

At the temporarily occupied territories there are still 90 units of SESU.

EVACUATION MEASURES

As of 28 January, more than 2,837,000 people were evacuated and accommodated across Ukraine, including more than 690,000 children and more than 86,000 people with disabilities.

ON THE RADIATION SITUATION ON THE TERRITORY OF UKRAINE

The radiation and fire safety situation at NPPs in Ukraine is within normal limits.

Zaporizhzhya NPP (Enerhodar) continues to operate to operate in the temporarily occupied territory.
